- The University of Cassino and Southern Lazio will send its decision within 2 weeks of the receipt of the nomination / application in case the nominated / applying student cannot be accepted. E MADRID05 will send its decision within four weeks.
- A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. *[It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]*
- Termination of the agreement

This agreement will remain in effect for the above determined period of validity or until the involved institutions both agree in the discontinuation of the exchanges. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. NB: Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict. *[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]*



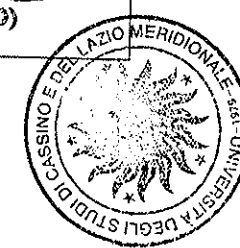
