^{*)}TAMK expects exchange students to have proficient English skills before coming to Finland. Teaching typically involves active student participation, class discussion, project work and student presentations. It means that you must have a command of the English language equivalent of the IELTS score of 6.0, the TOEFL score of 550 (paper-based test) or 80 (internet-based test) or level B2 in European Language Levels. Other equivalent proof of your English language competency is also acceptable.

- The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks from the application deadline.
- 3. A Transcript of Records with attendance dates will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. If the transcript is issued directly to the student, <u>a scanned copy of the transcript of records</u> will be sent to the international office of the sending institution.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
