Lesson 1: Designing slides for conference presentations.

This lecture highlights the main issues concerning the design of slides for presenting a paper in a conference.

The main topics covered in this lectures are: presentation structures, slides contents and graphical contents.

Lesson 2: Designing posters for conference presentations.

This lecture focuses on the design of posters for presenting research results in conferences. The lecture highlights the structure of the poster and the selection of the main results to include on the poster.
